

Outline for Summer Research Powerpoint Pt. II

Your powerpoint should include pictures, diagrams, maps, charts and not more than 10 words per slide. The pictures support what you will be saying as you present. The slides should be done artistically – they should look nice and be “easy on the eyes”. You can embed videos and use stock pictures but make sure that they support your point of view.

- Intro to your course – Title, slogan, grade level, . . .
- Intro to you – the teacher
- Course outline – What we will learn in 8 weeks
- Special events – outings, activities, . . .
- Argument for changing the way we do school
 - How will we run our classes – daily schedule
 - What is expected from students
 - “Class” rules
 - Why we are doing this course land-based
 - How will it be different from regular classes
 - List 5 highlights of the course
 - How will student work be assessed
- Special clothing, equipment, materials (all year)
- Outline what will happen in our first class
 - How long is it (minutes)
 - Where will we be
 - What will we learn
 - What should we wear/bring . . .
- Emergencies and how they will be treated
- Final argument – why this way of teaching/learning will be better for
 - Students
 - Teachers
 - Parents
 - School board
 - The Ministry of Education
